



Clue #2 Flying Geese

Step #1

Take (72) 2 7/8" squares of Contrast #1

Mark each of the 72 squares down the middle

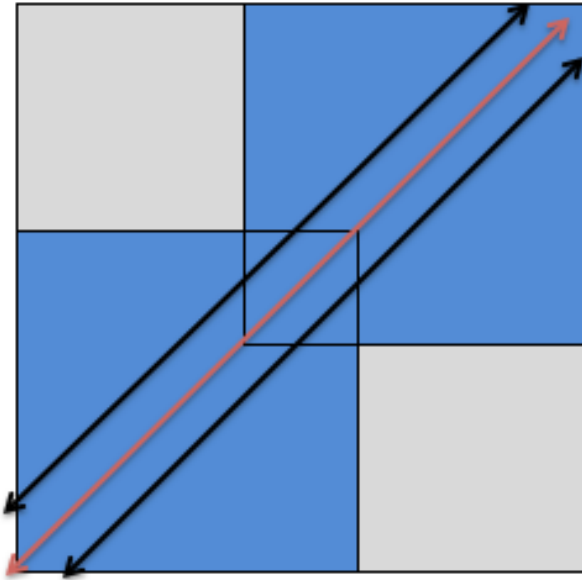


Step #2

Take (18) 5 1/4" neutral squares.

Lay the Contrast #1 squares on top of the background square (right sides together). Line up the drawn lines of the Contrast #1 squares as shown in red in the picture. Sew a 1/4" line on each side of the marked squares (shown in black in the picture.)

Step #3

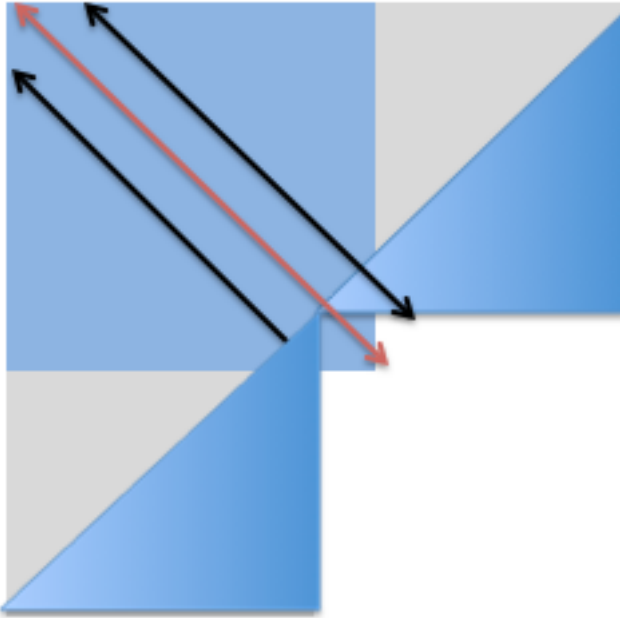
Cut on the drawn (red) line. Press towards Contrast #1. You will have 2 pieces that are like the picture. (I know it's weird, but bear with me!)



Step #4

Take a $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Contrast #1 square and place it on each of the Step #3 pieces (as shown in the picture. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " line away from the marked centres. (the black line)

Step #5

Cut along the centre (red line) and press towards Contrast #1

You will have 4 Flying geese from each 5 ¼" neutral square.

The flying geese block should look like this:



You should have 4 flying geese from each 5 ¼" background square.

Make 72 Flying Geese If you wish, label them "Flying Geese." Set aside

Now ... wasn't that easy? And you don't have any pesky waste triangles to worry about!
