## Clue \#3

## Part A:

Take the 3 of extra 10 " squares that you put aside in Clue \#1.
Cut them into (4) 10 " x 2.5 " rectangles. You will have 12 rectangles. I laid all 3 together and cut them at the same time.

## Part B:

Take the (36) $2.5 " \times 10 "$ rectangles [from Clue \#2] and the (12) $2.5 " \times 10 "$ rectangles [from Part A]. Mix them up, pairing contrasting rectangles together, then sew lengthwise. Press to the dark side.

Part C: Take the $2.5 " \times 7.5 "$ rectangles, ensure that they are with a contrasting fabric and sew them together lengthwise. Press to the dark side
